Bachelor's Degree in Data Analytics: English Language Admission Test

As part of the application process to the Bachelor's Degree in Data Analytics, this Department requires all applicants who do not possess an internationally certified English language proficiency (e.g. IELTS, PET) to sit an online **English language admission test** to verify that you are properly qualified to follow the course subjects thought in English. As well as being an entry requirement, this test gives you the chance to show your potential to succeed on your course, while giving us an extra piece of information for every candidate who has applied for a given course, wherever they are from.

Find out everything you need at this stage to know about taking an **English language admission test** as part of your university application.

Date and Format: The English language test will take place on Monday 4 September 2023 at 14.00 (local time) in the online format using Microsoft Teams platform. Shortly before this time, all applicants will receive an invitation to join the online test by the Department itself.

What the test is about: This test is a spoken, subject-specific admission test sat under short timed conditions and is designed to ascertain that you meet the English requirements to embark on undergraduate study, typically B1-B2 English CEFR level. Testing your level of English consists of answering a series of questions asked by the examiner to ensure that your intellectual and discussion-based approach focus on the general or specialised subject and issues at hand. The idea of this level test is to evaluate your knowledge and skills in different aspects of the spoken language such as grammar and vocabulary, among others. Throughout the webtesting, make sure that you choose a quiet, well-lit room to sit in.
